Dear Parents and Guardians,

Welcome to the new school year! Hopefully your child(ren) has/have been coming home with great stories about what happened at school this week. We are filled with excitement and optimism for the journey ahead. Our dedicated staff has been working to prepare for a year of growth, learning, and memorable experiences for your child(ren).

We have made some small changes this year that we believe will have a powerful positive effect on our school. Some of these changes have been prompted by the Ministry of Education and others by our staff. These changes are summarized below.

Daily Schedule:

8:13 am - 8:15 am: Homeroom

8:20 am - 9:35 am: Period 1

9:40 am - 10:55 am: Period 2

10:55 am - 11:55 am: Lunch

11:55 am - 1:10 pm: Period 3

1:15 pm - 2:30 pm: Period 4

Students have done a great job following this new schedule. Our schedule, which features a longer lunch hour, now allows only 5 minute travel time between morning and afternoon classes.

School Attendance – Every School Day Counts

Regular attendance is vital for academic success and personal growth. It builds knowledge, responsibility, and allows teachers to support individual needs, enhancing performance and classroom cohesion. Families can prioritize attendance by:

- Discussing its importance positively.
- · Keeping children home only when sick.
- Scheduling appointments outside school hours.
- Returning children to school after appointments.

Schools must track and report student attendance. To improve school attendance and accountability, students with unexplained absences or lates will face lunchtime detentions. Reducing Classroom Interruptions, Truancy and Tardiness (Lates)

Hall Pass System: students must now use a hall pass when leaving classrooms for washroom and body breaks. No more than two students may be out of a classroom at a time. Teachers will monitor students using a hall pass system. Students with a spare period must be in the Library or Cafeteria while on school premises. Students are responsible for being to school and class on time and will be assigned a detention if they are late or have an unexplained absence (truant).

Social Media and Cell Phone Restrictions

The Ministry of Education (Policy/Program 128 The Provincial Code of Conduct) mandates restrictions on cell phone use and social media during instructional time. Research shows that these distractions affect teaching and learning. Cell phones should not be visible or used during learning times unless approved by the educator for educational purposes only.

1 to 1 Technology/School Laptops for All Students

All students will be issued a school laptop to support their learning. Students must care for their device and bring it to classes as appropriate. They must sign an acceptable use agreement and are responsible for loss or damage. Device distribution will start next week (information to come).

Washroom Safety

Students are not permitted to congregate in washrooms. Vape detectors will be installed. Use the toilet, sink, and mirror, then leave. No other activities are permitted.

Medical Plans of Care
