

## **FSS Computer Programming**

On Feb 23, 13 of our students participated in the Canadian Computing Competition sponsored by the University of Waterloo, three of which received the Certificate of Distinction from scoring in the top 25% nation-wide: Daniel Ashby (Gr 9), Declan Jones (Gr 12), and Emily Paul (Gr 10).

On March 28, we sent 10 students to the Bayridge PAIRS Coding Competition. They had a blast, and one team took 3<sup>rd</sup> place amongst the 37 teams competing. Daniel Ashby (Gr 9) and Siddid Bhandar (Gr 9) received a medal and \$50 each for displaying coding talents.

On April 3, Makers Making Change came to lead an assistive tech workshop for 20 students in the library. They wired, soldered, and assembled a light proximity switch to allow individuals to switch on devices without the need to push a physical button.

There is another team coding competition coming up on May 8 at SLC. We will let you know how that goes!
